

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Cardiovascular Training Workout

Looking for a great way to get in shape without taking a class? Here is a sample of an effective cardiovascular plan created by Walter Sam, Director of Fitness & Aquatics.

Time: 45 minutes **Equipment:** Elliptical, Bike, Treadmill

Spend 15 minutes on each machine to total 45 minutes of cardiovascular training. The order of machine usage is up to you!

Elliptical – Begin at level 1 for 5 minutes. Advancing in level and speed every 2 minutes (base level off your fitness capability). MPH should match or be greater than each level.

Example:

Minutes	0-5	5-7	7-9	9-11	11-13	13-15
Level	1	5	6	7	8	9
MPH		5<	6<	7<	8<	9<

Cycling – Begin at level 5 for the first 5 minutes. Increasing the level and RPM every 5 minutes (base level and RPM off your personal fitness capability).

Example:

Minutes	0-5	5-10	10-15
Level	5	6	7
PRM	60-70	75-85	90-105

Treadmill – Beginning at an incline you will transition between a fast and a slow walk. Every **2** minutes your speed will change, and incline will reduce. Base your incline and speed off your fitness capability. (workout can be done without incline).

Example:

Minutes	0-3	3-5	5-7	7-9	9-11	11-13	13-15	15-17
Incline	7	6	5	4	3	2	1	0
Speed	3.7	3.2	3.7-4	3.2	3.7-4	3.2	3.7-4	2.5


