Dear Members,

Well, October already? With relief, I am happy that we are making another attempt at normalcy amid the pandemic. Hopefully, we do not have need to return to the noisome protocols of the past 20 months. That said, and to clarify, effective October 1, 2021:

## From the Kitchen...

Outfitting the kitchens with staff in previous months has been a huge challenge to say the least. With the addition of some key kitchen personnel in July and August, we are able to open the Seaside Dining Room back to its original six-day dinner operation (Tuesday through Sunday).



Expanding the Tavern Dinner Menu – The Tavern menu has been two pages of lunch items and a page of dinner items and daily features for quite some time now. We recently made the change to have the dinner options encompass an entire page of the menu and relocated the features to page four. On page four, the lunch features will be offered all day, while the dinner features start at 5:00. Both will change every other day (two lunch items / five dinner items) to be able to conserve paper and print newly listed features every two days. The dessert feature will continue to change every third day and advertised in the daily morning email as well as verbalized from your server.

With the kitchens back to being fully operational, the menus for all outlets will change monthly, allowing us to offer more variety and seasonality while letting us fluctuate menu pricing in accordance with the market. If there are any items you would like to see incorporated or revived from previous menus, feel free to send me an email.

There are still challenges when it comes to ordering and receiving product. Whether its “out of stock”, protein shortages, drastic price increases, delayed delivery times due to lack of drivers, etc., we will always try to make the impact as minimal as possible to you, the member.

## Audubon...

The Pileated Woodpecker is common in Florida although uncommon elsewhere. Similar to the size of a crow, it is the largest woodpecker. A solid black back, long neck, long tail with a prominent crest in all plumages are its distinguishing features. Its call is a series of resonant deep notes, never singular. The pileated woodpecker excavates oblong holes when feeding but round holes for nesting. A favorite food is carpenter ants.


