





Fitness Class Descriptions...

Spinning – Saddle up and experience the most enjoyable and effective workout to burn calories and lose weight, a class for all levels, riding a stationary bike where you are in control at all times using a resistance dial. Throughout the class you will experience a series of riding hills, intervals, and sprints with uplifting music to help you along the way.

Stretching – Floor exercises in which a specific muscle or tendon (or muscle group) is deliberately flexed or stretch in order to improve the muscle's elasticity and achieve comfortable muscle tone. Relax to smoothing music and you will find the result is a feeling of increased muscle control, flexibility, and range of motion.

Bare Barre – Using a combination of posture inspired by ballet and other disciplines like yoga and Pilates. The barre is used as a prop to balance while doing exercises that focus on isometric strength and isolation on specific muscle and muscle groups.

SWT (Solid Weight Training) – A (45) minute workout, with a combination of exercises using small apparatuses (bands, ball, weights). Doing plyometric moves to help strengthen small and large muscle groups.

Elements of Balance – A combo of ballet, Barre, static and dynamic and very graceful movements choreograph together with a mix of classical, jazz, rock, and soul music. This class will help stability and ability to prevent falls, by developing core muscle strength and improving ankle strength and lower extremely proprioception.

April 11 > from 4 - 6 p.m. Franz Lehár (1870-1948) Das Land Des Lachelns (The Land of Smiles)

While Franz Lehár operetta Das land Des Lachelns is best remembered for its tenor showpiece aria, "Dein ist mein Ganzes Herz", the score dazzles with other glorious musical moments. Originally presented in Vienna in 1923 as The Yellow Jacket the operetta was at first not well received. Lehár revised the score and the new production was presented at the Metropol Theatre in Berlin on October 10, 1929. The production was centered around the performance of the great tenor Richard Tauber, a close friend of Lehár's, for whom Lehár wrote a Tauberlied-a signature tune exploiting the exceptional qualities of Tauber's voice.

"You are my heart's delight" is likely the most famous of all the Tauberlieder.

The operetta is set in Vienna and China in 1912. Headstrong Lisa, daughter of a Viennese Count, falls in love with a Chinese Diplomat Prince Sou-Chong. Sou-Chong must return to China urgently, and despite the advice of her family and friends, Lisa leaves with him. Upon their arrival in China where all passions are concealed behind enigmatic smiles, Lisa finds herself unable to adapt to the demands placed upon her by Sou-Chong's country. Chinese custom dictates that Sou-Chong must take other wives. Despite assurances that the custom is just a formality, Lisa is locked in the palace where her love changes to hate. In the final act Sou-Chong is left alone while Lisa returns to Vienna.

The prince respects the "rules of his custom" and always smiles.
