

FROM THE KITCHEN

Mushrooms are plentiful this time of year. They are available year-round, but their peak season is during the fall and winter months. Mushrooms are the fleshy and edible fruit bodies of several species of macrofungi (fungi which bear fruiting structures that are large enough to be seen with the naked eye). They can appear either



below ground (hypogeous) or above ground (epigeous) where they may be picked by hand. Edibility may be defined by criteria that include absence of poisonous effects on humans and desirable taste and aroma. Edible mushrooms are consumed for their nutritional value and for their culinary worth. Mushrooms, especially dried shiitake, are sources of umami flavor which comes from guanylate. Wikipedia.com

Try this recipe with your favorite mushroom blend:

Wild Mushroom and Goat Cheese Strudel

2 T + 7 t Extra Virgin Olive Oil ¹/₂ cup Shallots, Thinly Sliced 4 cloves Garlic, Minced 1# Various Mushrooms, Washed and Chopped 1/3 cup Apple Cider Vinegar 1/3 cup Dry Sherry 2 T Parsley, Finely Chopped 3 sheets Phyllo Pastry ¹/₂ cup Goat Cheese, Crumbled

Heat 2 Tablespoons of oil in a large skillet over medium heat. Add shallots and garlic, sauté 4 minutes. Increase heat to high, add mushrooms and sauté until tender and golden (15 minutes). Add vinegar, then sherry, simmer until almost all liquid has evaporated (about 6 minutes). Season with salt and pepper. Cool and mix in 2 Tablespoons parsley.

Place 1 sheet of phyllo on work surface and brush with 2 teaspoons oil. Top with second sheet of phyllo and brush with 2 teaspoons oil. Top with third sheet of phyllo and brush with 2 teaspoons oil. Sprinkle cheese along one side of phyllo, 1 inch from edge. Spoon mushroom mixture over the cheese. Fold short ends over. Start along filled side, roll phyllo tightly. Place seam side down on baking sheet. Brush with remaining oil. Bake at 375 degrees until golden brown (about 40 minutes). Let strudel rest. Cut with serrated knife. Serve with balsamic reduction and micro greens.





The Future is Now Golf Clinics



It is possible to learn something new about your technique and to become a better player right now. Director of Golf Brad Myers will be conducting a series of golf clinics at the Links Course targeted to those that feel that they have maybe reached their potential and that don't feel that they are going to get any better. The clinics are open to women and men in all handicap ranges and will be held on Saturdays in October. In order to give you some flexibility in scheduling your Saturday golf round and to allow additional spots for signup, two clinics per day will be offered. Those times are 10 to 11 a.m. in the morning and afternoons from 1 to 2 p.m.

> The clinic dates and topics are as follows: Saturday, October 5-Full Swing Saturday, October 12 – Putting Saturday, October 19 – Full swing October 26 – Sand Game

Price is \$35 per person per hour and each clinic will be available to the first 6 people that signup for each clinic. We are capping the number of spots available so that each member can receive an appropriate amount of individual attention.

Pros Corner... PICKLEBALL DINKING TIPS

- **Quick footwork** learn to shuffle laterally, make this part of your dynamic warm-up, you'll get quicker.
- **Square your shoulders** to where the ball is coming from -face it.
- Avoid cross stepping avoid stepping across and turning your body away from the play as this opens a weakness on one side.
- Less wrist is better stiff wrist whenever possible, if they hit right at your feet you may need to twist your wrist more to scoop it up.
- **Flatten your paddle** when you dink think more of a line-drive, not an easy lob
- Dink to their feet.
- Change it up and dink down the middle sometimes. A lot of time dinking patterns end up going cross court but you can catch them both off guard by dinking straight down the middle.
- Dink shot out of the air standing toes to the line, reaching in and dink as it drops over the net (before the bounce). This gives them less time and gives you more angles. (1210)





Audubon Corner...

The turtle nesting report for the first part of the season is in and Hammock Dunes has had a lot of mama turtles visiting to lay their eggs! Here are some wonderful statistics from May 1 – July 1:



- In the 2.3 miles between Varn Park and Jungle Hut Road (inside our gates), there are 200 nests. This represents 53.7% of the Flagler South area and 37.8% of all the nests on the patrol beach area.
- There are 18.1 miles of beach in Flagler County, with a total of 529 nests. 407 are Loggerhead, 119 are Green and 3 are Leatherback nests.
- Sea Turtle False Crawls, where the turtle comes up the beach but doesn't make a nest or lay her eggs are a total of 190. Maybe those girls will come back another time.

The Club has had two nests hatch recently, so watch your emails for the Club's remaining nest to hatch. Congratulations on a successful nesting season!
