Covid-19 Holiday Season Policies & Procedures



GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Any members traveling outside of Palm Coast or having family or guests traveling to Palm Coast must observe a 10-day quarantine upon their return or upon their guest's arrival. During this quarantine period members and such guests (family or otherwise) are permitted to use outdoor amenities and services and takeout food service, grocery pickup or off premises wine sales. However, until the self-quarantine period has expired, access to the Fitness Center, in-house dining and indoor activities is not permitted.
- Face masks are required for all indoor activities. Proper mask usage always requires that the mask cover the nose and mouth.
- A temperature check will be performed on all members and guests on arrival to the Club.

GUESTS

• All immediate family guests must always be accompanied by the member. Such guests must have completed the self-quarantine period as described above.

FITNESS

- Use of the Fitness Center is limited to members and their immediate family only (parents, grandparents, children, grandchildren, siblings) who have completed the self-quarantine period.
- Fitness Classes will permit 10 foot spacing between participants.
- Participants are asked to allow social distancing while using equipment.

GOLF

- Tee times are required for play.
- Members who have recently traveled or who have guests or visitors who have traveled into Palm Coast may play while in the self-quarantine period.
- Members must share a cart with any guests (family or otherwise).
- Shop staff will monitor activity in the Golf Shops. Masks must be worn while shopping.

CROQUET, BOCCE, TENNIS & PICKLEBALL, POOL

- Court Reservations are required for use of the courts, outside of scheduled clinics and play.
- Members may book court time or participate in events if they have completed the self-quarantine. If the self-quarantine period is not completed, members and guests should observe social distancing.
- Members may bring guests to the pool while in the self-quarantine period, please observe social distancing from other parties, inclusive of in the water. Members and guests who have not completed the self-quarantine period are not permitted to participate in Aqua Aerobic classes.

DINING

- Advance reservations are required for seating in the dining areas.
- Seating in Rick's Bar is limited to the available seats. Standing, while socializing is only permitted if wearing a
- Table seating is limited to 8 or fewer.
- Masks must be worn unless the member or guest is seated and actively consuming food/beverage.
- No member or guest will be seated if they have not met the self-quarantine requirement.

SOCIAL EVENTS

- Social Events like Bingo and Trivia Night are for members and immediate family only if they have observed the self-quarantine procedure.
- A mask must always be worn over the nose and mouth while playing ANY card or game. If a member sips a beverage, they must replace the mask immediately after doing so.

On mornings when starting times are delayed due to frost, fog or rain, the following policy will be implemented:

In the event of a delay all tee times will be moved back an amount of time equal to the duration of the delay. Play will commence when it is determined by the maintenance staff that the course is prepared for play. It is imperative that rescheduled groups be at the tee and ready to play when called.

Audubon Corner...

One of the most beautiful birds that live here year round is the Northern Cardinal. Cardinals do not migrate. They get their name because the color of the male's feathers is bright red like the clothing often worn by a Catholic Cardinal. Thought as the Christmas bird, cardinal has a spiritual meaning as the color red equals vitality and creativity. The Cherokee Indians believe the cardinal is an omen and the daughter of the earthly sun. If you see it fly downward it is bad luck. If you see it fly upward it is good luck.



The female is quite different from the male but no less beautiful. She is an even brown with warm red accents. Normally found in an open woodland habitat, this bird likes to sit low in scrubs near the ground. The Cardinal is a seed eater, sunflower seeds are a favorite, and has developed a very strong bill for this purpose. During the mating season the male feeds the female, this is called mate feeding. The pair does mate for life.

It is illegal to own or kill a Cardinal. They are a protected wild bird species under the "Migratory Bird Treaty Act of 1918"


