From the Kitchen...

In early 2021, Jim Guzzaldo (our prior Pastry Chef) and I started to formulate a plan to incorporate fresh breads into our culinary program. We knew the required necessities (steam injected oven, couches for baguettes, sourcing certain ingredients from numerous suppliers, etc.) but most of all needed that ONE person that would want to undertake the responsibilities of feeding the starters, preparing the doughs, shaping, baking, and give consistent quality daily. That staff individual was already here at the Club... Nicole Parker raised her hand and wanted to be that person. So with mentorship from Jim, she started baking bread about 8 months ago. He gave her a book on the science of bread and instructed her to read it on her free time. She immersed herself into bread baking. One week later was done with the book and had her shifts reassigned to begin the development of the program. Ever since then, she has been incorporating different rolls, braids, loafs, sandwich style breads and has gained an appreciation and understanding for the process.

In December 2021, I signed up for two competitions of my own to take place in January 2022 in Myrtle Beach, SC and came across a category I had not seen before. C-5 Bread Display. I thought: I would be there competing anyway, so I could transport the product and set up her Bread Display to be judged, then relay the critique back to Nicole. I volleyed the idea to her and explained all the benefits of competing. At first she was hesitant. There is fear in competition – the fear of failure, the fear of putting up an inferior product, fear of not having enough time in timed events, etc... BUT I explained, on the opposite side, fear is a great motivator. "I don't want to fail, so how do I avoid that?" – practice-practice-practice to perfect the process, eliminate as many variables as possible, plan your timeline so you are comfortable; most of all listen to the critiques that the judges give and use that to become even better in the next one.

On Monday – January 14, 2022 her bread display was judged by none other than Internationally known Olympian Pastry Chef Susan Notter. Critiques that are given are honest and constructive to make individuals understand their strong areas and areas they need to focus on. I took down all the notes that Chef Notter explained and upon my return to the Club passed along the information to Nicole and discussed ways to incorporate the suggestions. She was also presented her with her first competition BRONZE medal and certificate. Congratulations to Nicole! I am super proud of her for jumping in to the competition arena and I think (like me) she is addicted, because she has already asked "when is the next one"...?



NEW and coming soon to the Hammock Dunes Fitness Center: PRIVATE Pilates reformer classes.

Invented by Joseph Pilates, Pilates is a style of exercise that focuses on core strength and stability, stretching the muscles, and



building lean muscle mass throughout the body. Reformer machines are a widely used mechanism of incorporating Pilates into a workout routine. They are designed to work every muscle in the body, while strengthening and lengthening the muscles.

The reformer is a spring-loaded machine, meaning you can increase and decrease resistance placed against the body by adding or taking away the adjustable springs. The machine consists of a sliding carriage where you can sit, stand, or lie flat, with an adjustable foot-bar to create variations in exercises. Ropes with straps that can be placed in the hands or around the feet, provide an additional way to create resistance.

While reformers are great for overall strength, they are also excellent apparatuses to stretch the muscles, and when used in a regular workout regimen, facilitate stamina and stability.

The machines are also common in rehabilitation work, focusing on slow and controlled movements and specializing in core control, balance, strength, and flexibility.

Robins and Whales?

Did you know that Hammock Dunes is one of the few and only places in the world you can see Robins and Right Whales at the same time?



Let's start with Right Whales, that migrate through our local oceans in January. There are approximate 350 individuals left and are protected under the Federal Marine Mammal Act and the Endangered Species Act.

Marine vessels are required to stay 500 yards (5 football fields) away so that mother and calf can bond. The species could be extinct in 20 years without our help. Our Hammock Dunes Club whale watching team is led by Sharon Davis (313-333-7344) and Tina Bjarekull (443-520-0453).



In January, Robins migrate to our area numbering in the tens of thousands. Their main diet is berries from cabbage palms and insects. The Creek Course is one of their favorite places to overnight. When they depart in late February, spring weather is on the way!
