

From the Kitchen...

Throughout my career, I get many questions on the type of chef's knife that I use, how to sharpen it, what is honing, etc... When selecting a chef's knife (or line of knives) much of it is based on personal preference: the weight of the knife, the balance, the length, how big of a heel/bolster, what your familiar with, cost and so many other factors. As I continue in my career, I find that I have changed numerous times to different brands. First starting off at the CIA the issued knife kit was Frederick Dick, then I moved to Henckels and Wusthof (all European), now I am on to the Japanese Global. (www.globalcutleryusa.com). I landed on Global because they are light, thin, balanced, have ergonomic handles with a non-traditional riveted handle look. They stay sharp, are very precise, sharpened on both sides and made from stainless steel.

PARTS OF A KNIFE



Next month I will review the practice of sharpening (and keeping) your knives sharp. I use an oil tri-stone, finished with a honing ceramic rod - as opposed to the classical cylindrical honing steel.

Lightning Detection Policy / Procedure

Members are expected to exercise reasonable prudence and common sense when severe weather, e.g., thunder or lightning, is reported or observed in the area.

Both golf courses have sirens that will sound to notify all members on the golf courses, practice facilities, croquet lawns, pool and tennis facilities that dangerous weather is in the area. Immediately upon hearing the siren sound (one long blast), all members must leave their outdoor activities and seek appropriate shelter.

The siren will sound again (three short blasts) when it is safe to resume to outdoor activities. Members who fail to exercise prudence and common sense by evacuating the golf course when lightning is observed or reported, may be subject to Board discipline.

The golf course weather feature on the Club App is available to all members and will indicate when it is safe to resume outdoor activities.



- Their sex is determined by the temperature of the egg.
